## Library

The library is a community resource hub for all tribal members and surrounding community members. We offer many services to our patrons. We are the first Tribal Public Library in the Southwest of New Mexico.

We provide free internet access, including Wi-Fi with 12 public computers and circulate over 100 items on a weekly basis. We offer basic computer classes on an individual basis upon request; we base our collection purchases on patron request.

We have text book program for our college students, we spend on an average of at least \$5000 for textbooks per semester. We assist with many federal programs online and with personal and business needs. We offer literacy and early literacy programs and collaborate with other department programs for our youth. We assist with community service and take volunteers on a daily basis.

We provide equipment services and technology services, fax, phone, printing, laminating, book binding, butcher paper, PA system meeting space and tutoring.

We utilize the Insignia library software to circulate and maintain all of the library material and equipment.
